The office of the Resident Commissioner Govt. of Himachal Pradesh was established in New Delhi in 1973-74. The purpose of establishing this office was to maintain high level liaison with Ministries of Government of India , other State Governments, foreign Diplomatic Missions, International agencies and members of Parliament with the objective of :-

(a) Promoting the interests of the State in the matter of location of central projects.

(b) Encouraging entrepreneurs to make investments in Industries, Tourism, Horticulture, Power & other Sectors in Himachal Pradesh.

©Making special efforts to represent meaningfully the The State Government in negotiations/discussions on Vital matters with Central/State Governments and Bilateral & multilateral agencies.

The Office of the Resident Commissioner has come to be recognized by the Central & State Government Offices and other organizations located in Delhi as an established channel of communication between the Central and State Governments, especially on all urgent & time bound matters. The main functions and duties of this office are to act as a bridge between the Central Government, its institutions/ other agencies and Himachal Government to promote the overall interest of the State Govt.

The multifarious duties of this Office range from maintaining high level liaison with Ministries/ Departments/ Institutions in Government of India, foreign Diplomatic Missions, International donors/ Aid Agencies, to interacting with entrepreneurs for encouraging investments in the State not merely in the traditional fields of Agriculture, Horticulture, Cottage Industries etc. but in the upcoming and frontier areas of Energy, Information Technology, Biotechnology, Forestry, Floriculture, Tourism, Health, Alternate system of Medicine, Education etc. As and when required this office follows up matters pending with the Centre Government

Offices and other agencies where prolonged correspondence by the State Government has not brought forth results; to provide material, whenever required by the MPs to take up pending matters concerning H.P State in Parliament; to receive H.E.the Governor, Hon'ble Chief Minister other Ministers and to provide protocol on their visit to Delhi. The main duty of this office is to liaise with the Central Government (Ministries/ Departments), other State Government offices, Private and Public Sector Organizations to promote the interest of the State Government .
